## **Voorhees College Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF II)**

- 1. Voorhees College has signed and submitted to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement form as required.
- 2. Voorhees College has received \$1,124,053.00 from the Department of Education pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement, of which \$1,124,053.00 has been disbursed to students.
- 3. The institution has disbursed \$562,027.00 to students in the respective quarters listed below.

- 4. Unlike HEERF I, 100% of enrolled students are eligible. Students are not required to be Title IV eligible.
- 5. As of today, 330 students have received an emergency financial aid grant.
- 6. Based on the requirements of the CRRSAA of 2021, the institution determined the amount of the grants based on students who were enrolled at the institution with the demonstrated greatest amount of need based on EFC or their expenses. The students showing the greatest need received up to \$2,000.00.
- 7. The College informed all enrolled students and their parents of the CRRSAA availability via their email provided on their FAFSA application or their institutional email. The funds were disbursed to students via check.
